Today, when MA/1259/17 was taken up, learned Senior counsel for the applicants submitted that the applicants do not wish to stand in the way of the Board of BSNL taking a decision on the scheme which was the subject matter in MA-1. Their concern was only to the effect that action consequent to such approval, if given, should not be without all stakeholders including the applicants being informed of the same.

The learned counsel for BSNL submitted that he is in agreement with the submission made by the learned counsel for the applicants and the respondents 2 and 3 have no objection whatsoever to the plea made on behalf of the applicants.

It is ordered that the interim stay issued during the proceedings on 20.12.2017 be lifted. The Board of BSNL will be at liberty to consider, deliberate and take a decision on the scheme as contained in MA-1. However, it is further directed that any action consequent to such approval, if given, will be initiated only after 10 days of publication of the scheme in its approved form in the official website of BSNL.

M.A is disposed of as above.
